

FOREWORD

1. Civil Airworthiness Requirements are issued by the Department of Civil Aviation (herein after referred to as DCA), under the authority of Civil Aviation Regulations and specify the minimum requirements for issue of approvals and certificates required for airworthiness and operation of civil aircraft registered in Mauritius.
2. Should any conflict of interpretation occur between these Civil Airworthiness Requirements and the Civil Aviation Regulations, the interpretation of the Civil Aviation Regulations shall take precedence.
3. The Requirements have been divided into various chapters; compliance with the Requirements is mandatory for grant and renewal of approvals and certificates issued by this department.
4. Minor changes to the Requirements will be issued in the form of amendments. Each amendment will be issued with a number, an effective date and a reference to the Chapter to which it relates.
5. In the event of substantial changes to the requirements, a new Chapter with a new issue number will be issued. The old issue shall be treated as cancelled and must be destroyed unless otherwise advised by Director of Civil Aviation.
6. A yearly list of current requirements together with applicable amendments will be issued.
7. "Civil Airworthiness Requirements" is a priced document and may be obtained from the Director of Civil Aviation on payment of the appropriate fee. Amendments will be issued to registered holder(s), free of cost.
