

## External Trade – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2008

### Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the fourth quarter of 2008 and for the years 2007 and 2008. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2007 published in this indicator are final, those for 2008 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the year 2008 some 47% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

### 1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the fourth quarter of 2008 was valued at Rs 55,258 million, i.e 5.0% higher than the previous quarter and 2.3% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2007.

During the fourth quarter of 2008, total exports were valued at Rs 19,932 million against imports of Rs 35,326 million.

For the year 2008, total exports amounted to Rs 68,409 million, 1.9% lower than in 2007 and imports Rs 132,564 million, 9.5% higher than in 2007, the trade deficit being Rs 64,155 million, i.e 25.0% higher than in 2007. Exclusive of aircraft worth Rs 2,730 million purchased in 2007, the trade deficit for the year 2008 compared to the previous year showed an increase of 32.0%.



## 2. Exports

### 2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2008, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 19,932 million, showing an increase of 9.2% over the previous quarter but a slight decrease of 0.5% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2007.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 70.1% of total exports, went up by 15.7% from Rs 12,071 million in the previous quarter to Rs 13,971 million in the fourth quarter of 2008. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2007, domestic exports were 6.0% lower. For the fourth quarter of 2008 re-exports stood at Rs 3,204 million, i.e lower by 17.3% and 10.9% compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2007 respectively.

Total exports for the year 2008 reached Rs 68,409 million, showing a decrease of 1.9% over the year 2007.

### 2.2 Exports by SITC section - (Year 2008)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the year 2008 amounted to Rs 18,548 million showing a decrease of 5.7% over the year 2007. Exports of sugar went down by 13.7% and those of "fish and fish preparations" went down marginally by 1.9% (Table 3).

For the year 2008, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 5,283 million, lower by 6.9% when compared to exports of a value of Rs 5,675 million in 2007.

Total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" for the year 2008 registered a decrease of 8.3% compared to the year 2007 mainly attributable to lower re-exports of mobile phones by freeport operators.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 47.7% of total exports for year 2008, declined by 11.4% compared to 2007 to reach Rs 28,337 million. For the period under review, exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" representing 85.0% of exports of this section showed a decrease of 12.7%.

### 2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises(EOE) - (Year 2008)

During the year 2008, exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 34,932 million showing a decrease of 7.7% compared to 2007 (Table 1). Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 23 March 2009.

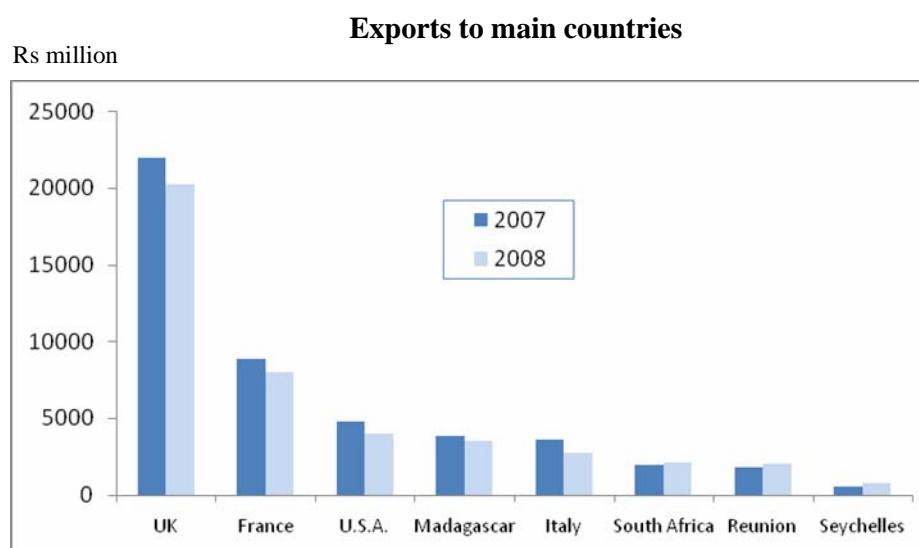

<sup>2</sup> Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

## 2.4 Exports by Country of destination - (Year 2008)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the year 2008 shows that the European countries were the main buyers, purchasing some 67.9% of our exports for an amount of Rs 40,392 million. The United Kingdom remained the most important market with a share of 34.0% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.4%), U.S.A (6.7%), Madagascar (5.9%), Italy (4.6%) and South Africa (3.6%) - (Table 7).

Compared to the year 2007, total exports to our major markets namely UK, France, U.S.A and Madagascar went down by 7.8%, 10.5%, 16.3% and 9.1% respectively. A decrease of 25.8% was also recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones. However, it is interesting to note that exports to emerging markets of the region i.e South Africa, Reunion and Seychelles registered increases of the order of 8.6%, 10.8% and 32.8% respectively. Further details are given in Table 7.



## 3. Imports

### 3.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2008 reached Rs 35,326 million, showing an increase of 2.8% over the figure of Rs 34,358 million for the previous quarter but a decrease of 3.3% over the corresponding quarter of 2007.

Total imports for the year 2008 stood at Rs 132,564 million, showing an increase of 9.5% over the year 2007. Exclusive of aircraft imported in 2007, total imports for 2008 went up by 12.1%

### 3.2 Imports by SITC section - (Year 2008)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the year 2008 amounted to Rs 23,872 million, i.e 19.2% higher than in 2007. The most significant increases were noted in imports of rice (+49.6%), dairy products (+23.1%), and fish and fish preparations (+21.0%) – (Table 10).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 28,352 million, representing a rise of 27.8% over the previous year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the year 2008 went up slightly by 1.2% to reach Rs 25,035 million.

For the year 2008, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at Rs 26,272 million decreased by 7.9% compared to 2007. Exclusive of the purchase of aircraft in 2007, imports of this section showed an increase of 1.8%.

Imports of “*Miscellaneous manufactured articles*” stood at Rs 10,807 million, going up by 12.8% compared to 2007.

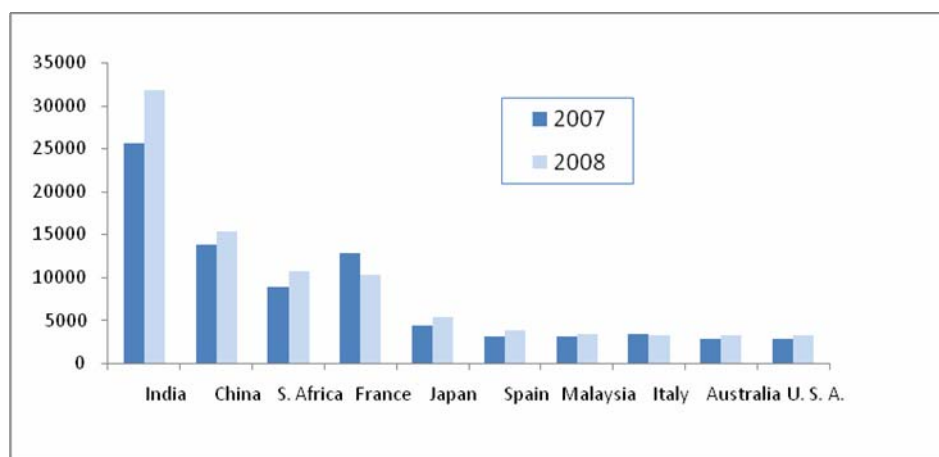
### 3.3 Imports by country of origin – (Year 2008)

During the year 2008, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 71,679 million with a share of 54.1% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (23.9%), China (11.5%), South Africa (8.1%), France (7.7%), Japan (4.1%), Spain (2.8%), Malaysia (2.6%), Italy (2.5%), Australia (2.4%) and U.S.A (2.4%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006 (Table 13).

### 4. Trade with Regional Organisations – (Year 2008)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the year 2008 stood at Rs 7,634 million, against imports of Rs 15,487 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 7,853 million.

During the year 2008 our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 5,006 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 4,037 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of Rs 969 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 70.2%. The main products exported to Madagascar were preparations used in animal feed and

looped pile cotton fabrics. Our main suppliers were Kenya (25.7%), Egypt (23.8%), Madagascar (16.3%) and Seychelles (14.3%). Our imports from Kenya consisted mainly of cigarettes while portland cement, urea, cleaning preparations and iron bars constituted the main products imported from Egypt. Frozen yellowfin tunas and frozen skipjack were the main products imported from Seychelles (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the year 2008 showed a deficit of Rs 6,598 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 12,508 million and exports worth Rs 5,910 million. The main supplier was South Africa (85.6%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (59.5%) and South Africa (36.4%) - (Table 16).

### **5. Trade in Freeport Zone - (Year 2008)**

During the year 2008, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 5,165 million, a figure which is lower by 14.0% compared to 2007. The most significant decreases were noted in imports of “Fish and fish preparations”, “Textile yarn, fabrics and made up articles” and “Telecommunications equipment, n.e.s; parts & accessories etc.” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 8,890 million, showing a decrease of 17.1% when compared to the year 2007. This is mainly attributable to a contraction in the re-exports of “Telecommunications equipment, n.e.s” coupled with a decrease in the re-exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” sourced from Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 6).

## Notes

### (1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

### (3) Classification

#### (i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
