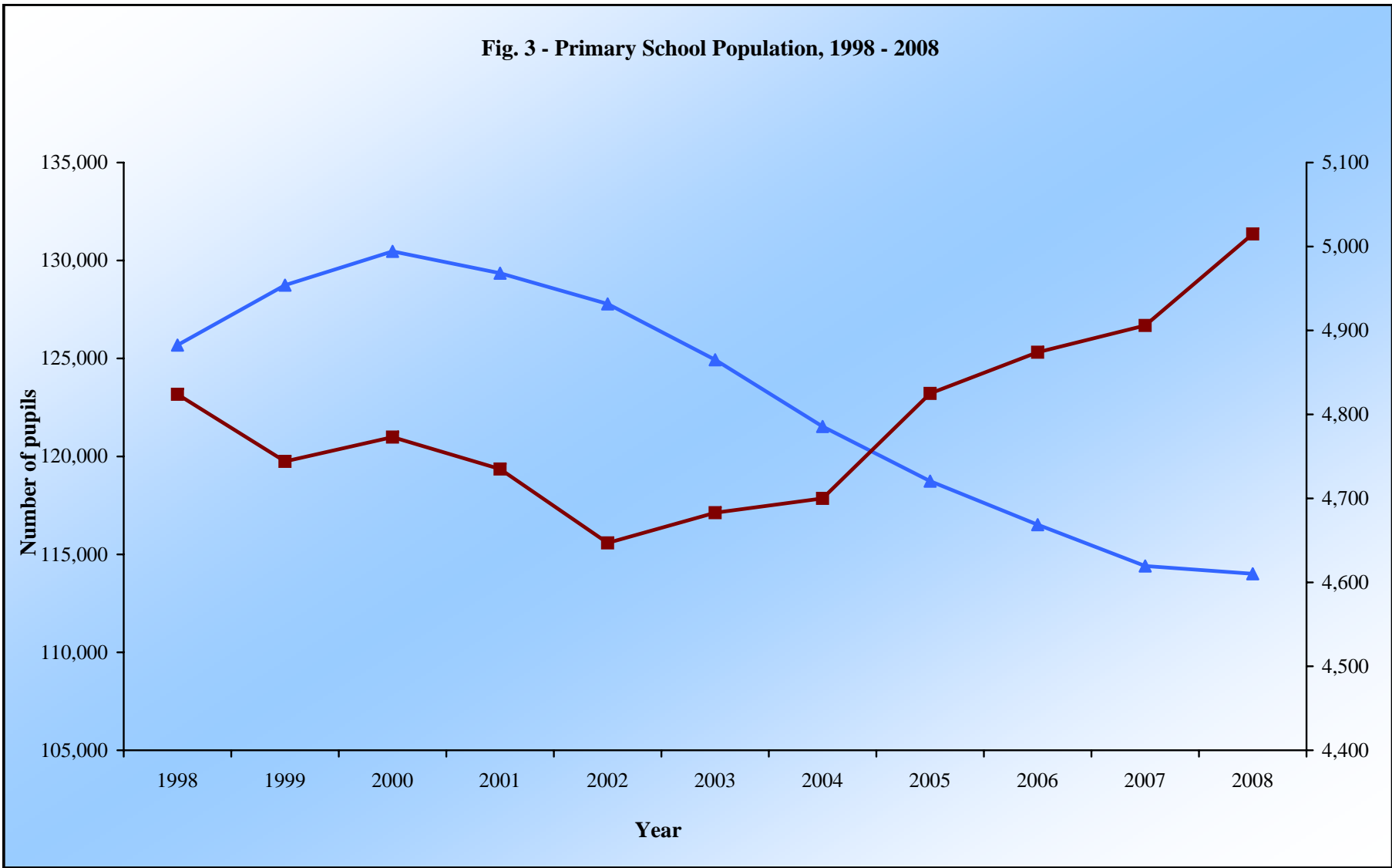

**Fig. 4 - Gross Enrolment Ratio at Primary level, 1998 - 2008**

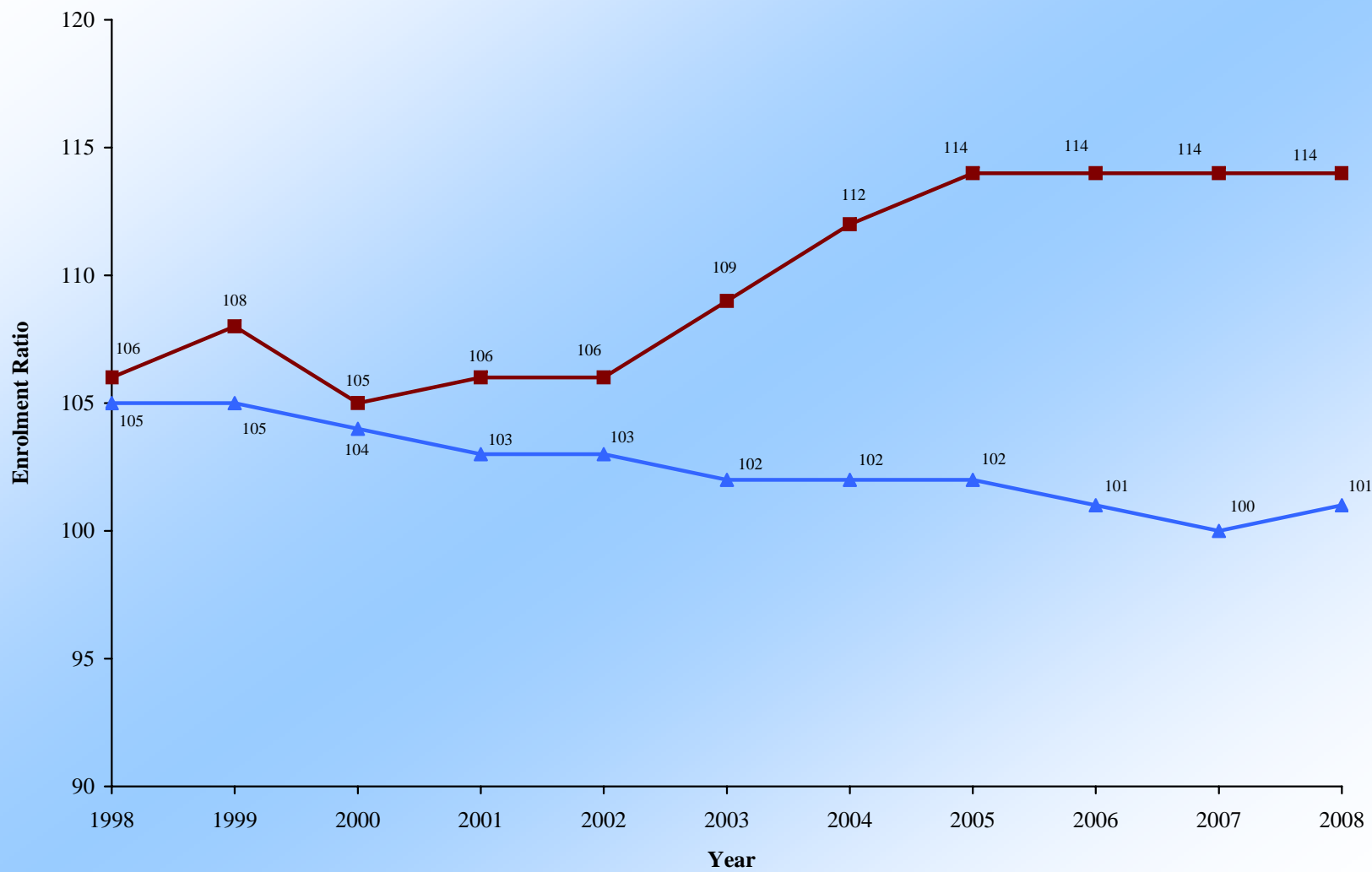

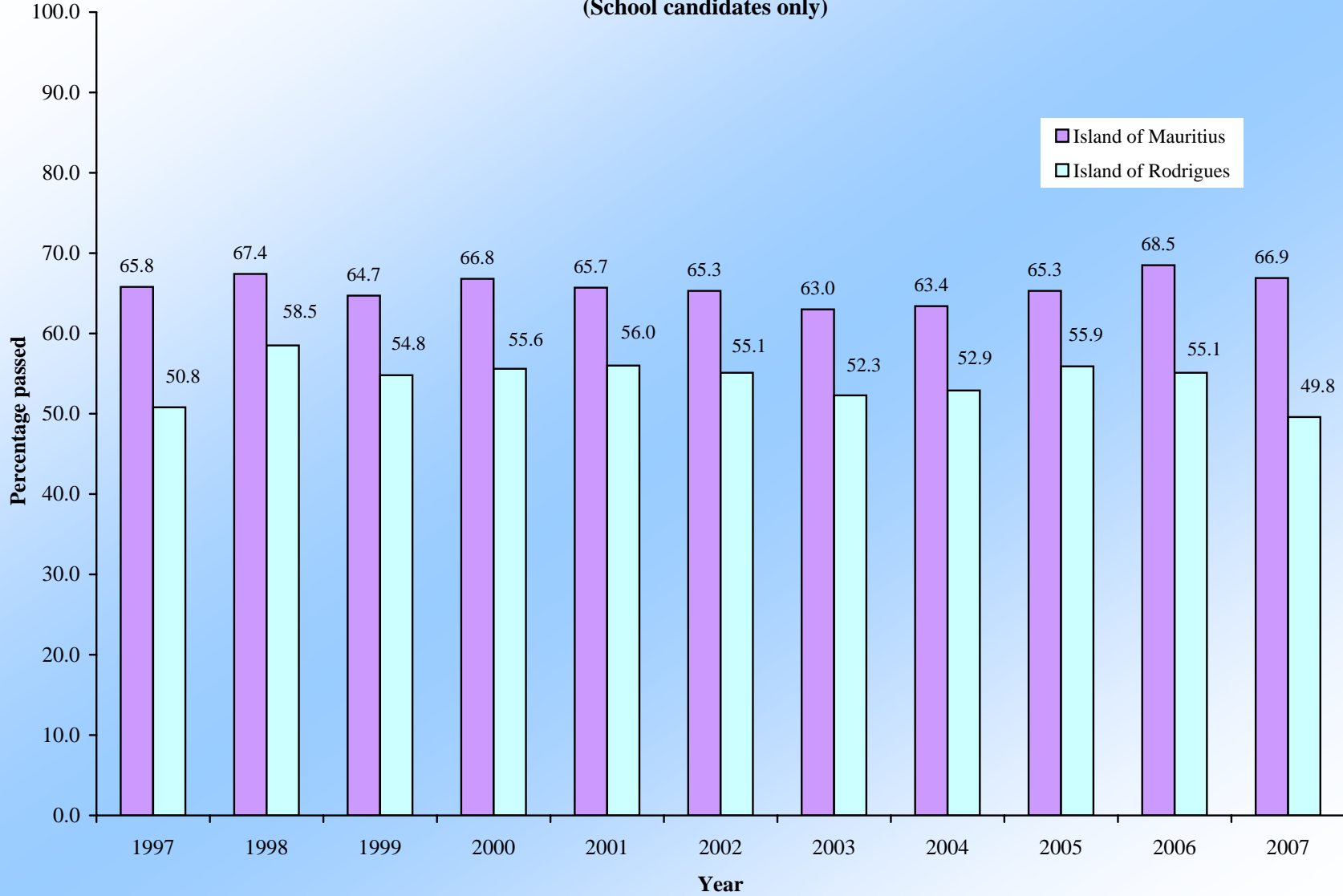
