Transfer/admission in Lower VI of State Secondary Schools/Colleges, Mahatma Gandhi Secondary Schools/Institute and Rabindranath Tagore Secondary School

Applications are invited from eligible students for transfer/admission in Lower VI of State Secondary Schools/Colleges, Mahatma Gandhi Secondary Schools (MGSS)/ Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI) and Rabindranath Tagore Secondary School (RTSS).

Seats will be allocated, **subject to the availability of vacancies**, on the basis of approved criteria, while giving an equal consideration to all requests, irrespective of whether the student is attending a state or a private institution or is a private candidate.

Pre-requirement

The student must satisfy the eligibility criteria for promotion to Lower VI **and** those in respect of the subject combination opted for.

How to apply

1. State Secondary School students should fill in their forms in their respective schools **on Tuesday 8 February or Wednesday 9 February 2011.**
2. Other students should call at one of the centres below **on Tuesday 8 February or Wednesday 9 February 2011 between 09 00 and 15 00** to fill in an Application Form:

4. Applications not made on the prescribed Application Form or received outside the exercise (e.g. by way of letter to the Ministry) will **not** be considered.

Documents required

1. Original of the SC Results
2. Original of the Birth Certificate

Criteria for allocation of seats

Processing of requests and allocation of seats will be done by the MES on the basis of the following:

1. Order of preference of schools and subject combinations at Principal Level
2. SC grade aggregate
3. Sub-aggregate in the subjects to be taken at Principal Level in case of ties

Remarks

- Students seeking a transfer in Lower VI may apply for any number of National or Regional schools of their choice. However, the Regional school(s) applied for must be in the same zone as their place of residence.
- **Once a seat has been allocated in a school, a change of subject combination will NOT be entertained.**
- Successful candidates will, on the day of registration, be required to choose their subsidiary subject among those offered by the school where they have been admitted/transferred. **Any subsequent request for a change in the subsidiary subject will NOT be entertained.**

Wherever a given teaching group is of size less than the minimum required, the Ministry reserves the right not to offer the subject combination
