

SCIENCE EXTENSION CLASSES JUNE – OCTOBER 2009

The Ministry of Education, Culture & Human Resources proposes to run Extension Classes in Practical Biology, Chemistry and Physics in State Secondary Schools from **June 2009 to October 2009**.

- The Extension Classes are open to G.C.E “A” Level students who have passed the Cambridge School Certificate or its equivalent in the appropriate science subject and **who are not attending a secondary school**.
- The Ministry will also consider applications from students who are still attending a Secondary School and who wish to sit for the GCE ‘A Level in an additional **Science Subject** which they are **not** currently studying at their schools.
- Each practical session of two (2) hours will be run at least once weekly and will start at 3.30 p.m. A total of twenty (20) practicals in each subject will be offered.
- Interested students are invited to call at one of the following **Customer Care Desks, on any working day from Tuesday 26 to Friday 29 May 2009, between 9.00 a.m and 3.00 p.m.**, to fill the appropriate application form.

- Applications may also be submitted online at <http://citizen.gov.mu> and choosing “Application for use of labs for Science Extension Classes” among the list of available e-services. However, applicants will be required to subsequently call at the Ministry’s HeadQuarters, IVTB House, Phoenix, to submit all necessary documents.
- All Applicants should produce their:-
 - (1) **Birth Certificate and Identity Card** (where applicable) (**original + 1 photocopy**)
 - (2) **School Certificate or “O” Level Certificate** (**original + 1 photocopy**)In the case of applicants under the age of twenty, in addition to (1) and (2) above, they should produce
either (3) **their School Leaving Certificate** (**original + 1 photocopy**)
or (4) if still attending a Secondary School, **Certification from the Head of their school** that they are not studying the subject applied for at their present school.
- The fee for the whole period is five hundred (500) rupees per subject and is payable on enrolment at the Finance Section, (Cash Office Room 235) Ministry of Education, Culture & Human Resources, 2nd floor, IVTB House, Phoenix.
- The allocation of a particular college will be determined on the basis of selection of applicants and the number of applications received in a particular subject. However, the Ministry reserves the right not to run classes for a particular subject in case of an insufficient number of qualified applicants.
