Applications are invited from suitably qualified Mauritian Nationals for the award of 32 scholarships by D. Y. Patil Educational Society, India as follows:

*Potential Candidates successfully completing their Diploma will be eligible for scholarships to complete undergraduate studies in their particular fields.

2. **Eligibility Requirements**

Qualifications

(A) For Diploma Courses

- (i) SC/GCE 'O' level with credits in at least five subjects including English Language at one and the same sitting; and
- (ii) A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at Principal level and a Pass in GP at one and same sitting.

(B) For Undergraduate Studies

SC/GCE 'O' level with credits in at least five subjects including English Language at one and the same sitting.

(i) for MBBS/BAMS

A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry, Biology at Principal level and a minimum of grade 'c' in GP at one and same sitting.

(ii) B-Pharmacy

A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics at Principal level and a minimum of grade 'c' in GP at one and the same sitting.

(iii) Engineering/Architecture

A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at Principal level and a Pass in GP at one and same sitting.

(iv) Biotechnology

A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry, Biology at Principal level and a Pass in GP at one and same sitting.

(v) Bachelor of Education

Possession of a BA, BSc or BCom with a minimum of second class.

(C) Postgraduate Studies

(vi) M-Pharmacy

- (i) SC/GCE 'O' level with credits in at least five subjects including English Language at one and the same sitting;
- (ii) A minimum of grade 'C' in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at Principal level and a Pass in GP at one and same sitting; and

- (iii) A minimum standard of Upper Second Class Honours Bachelor's Degree in B-Pharmacy.

3. Age Limit

Candidates should be more than 17 years of age but less than 25 years by the closing date of submission of application for undergraduate studies. As for **B.Ed & M-Pharmacy**, candidates should not be more than 35 years of age.

4. Conditions

- 4.1 The scholarships will cover only tuition fees.
- 4.2 Hostel accommodation will be provided by the institutions; however, scholars will be required to pay the fee fixed by the respective institutions.
- 4.3 Living expenses and cost of air-tickets will have to be borne by the scholars.
- 4.4 Applicants are reminded that being nominated by the Ministry does not automatically guarantee final selection for an award. The final decision to award the scholarships rests with the donor Institution.
- 4.4 Only the best-qualified candidates will be nominated. Candidates who have not been informed of their shortlisting within six weeks as from the closing date for application should consider that they have not been nominated.

5. Mode of Application

- 5.1 Applications must be made on the prescribed form available at the Scholarships Section, Ministry of Education and Human Resources, 1st Floor, MITD House, Phoenix, or downloaded from the Ministry's website:

However, applicants should submit **certified** copies of all supporting documents within three working days after application for the scholarship online.

- 5.2 The completed Application Form along with all supporting documents should be submitted to the Scholarships Section of the Ministry by **Monday 8 August 2011 at 14.00 hours at latest.**

- 5.3 Candidates should ensure that originals along with certified copies of certificates, transcripts of final university results/marksheets and all other relevant documents relating to their qualifications are submitted to the Scholarships Section, along with their applications by the closing date. **Non-submission of same in due time will result in elimination from the nomination exercise.**
- 5.4 Responsible parties of applicants not in Mauritius may apply on behalf of their wards.
- 5.5 Applicants already in employment, whether public or private, must fill in the application forms in duplicate. One copy thereof along with the relevant supporting documents should be submitted to the Scholarships Section, and one copy to the applicant's employer to enable the latter to decide on the release of applicant for the course, and if so, on what terms and conditions. **Such information should be made available by the closing date.**
- 5.6 A Communiqué will be placed on the website of the Ministry in due course to inform applicants that the nomination exercise has been completed.
- 5.7 All documents/supporting evidence should be in English or accompanied by a translation in English.
