Fellowships from Germany - Five week Exchange Programme

The Federal Agency for Civic Education (Bundeszentrale für politische Bildung/bpb) is offering fellowships to students and young graduates of East Africa to attend a five week seminar to be held from 14 to 29 August 2011 in Germany and in March 2012 in Kenya.

The seminar will be conducted exclusively in English.

Conditions

Students and young graduates should be between 21 to 28 years of age and be studying or have a degree in political science, modern history, international relations, economics, business administration, African studies, cultural studies, media & communication studies or law.

Potential candidates wishing to apply must submit an essay of 3 A4 pages (6000 characters) written in English on the following themes:

- (1) The Constitution in Kenya and Germany
- (2) Transnational river basins: the Nile – potential for conflict or cooperation
- (3) Jointly coordinated security policy of the AU & EU
