

## **COMMUNIQUE**

### **OFFER OF PART-COST SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE JSS ACADEMY OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION, MAURITIUS**

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Mauritian candidates for the award of **twelve** part-cost scholarships at undergraduate level offered by JSS Mahavidyapeetha (JSSMVP), Mysore, and tenable at JSS Academy of Technical Education, Mauritius. The courses will start from July 2011 with a one-month Foundation course.

The scholarships are for the following **full-time** engineering courses:

1. Civil Engineering
2. Electrical & Electronics Engineering
3. Computer Science & Engineering
4. Electronics & Communication Engineering

#### **2. Eligibility Criteria**

- (i) SC/GCE 'O' level with credits in at least five subjects including English at one and the same sitting;
- (ii) HSC with passes in Physics and Maths at Principal level, in addition to a pass at Principal level in **one** of the following subjects: Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science/ Biotechnology/ Electronics/ Design & Technology; and
- (iii) Candidates must also have a pass in General Paper at the same sitting as at (ii) above.

#### **3. Age Limit**

Candidates should not have reached **22** years of age by the closing date.

4. Under this Scheme, 50% of the annual tuition fee (amounting to MUR 30,000) will be waived.

#### **5. Mode of Application**

- 5.1 Applications must be made on the prescribed form available at the Scholarships Section, Ministry of Education and Human Resources, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, MITD House, Phoenix, or downloaded from the Ministry's website:

- 5.4 All candidates should ensure that **certified** copies of educational certificates and other relevant documents are submitted to the Scholarships Section, along with their applications. **Non-submission of same by the closing date will result in elimination from the nomination exercise.**
- 5.5 Only the best candidates will be selected. Candidates who would not have been informed of their selection within eight weeks as from the closing date for application should consider that their applications have not been successful.
6. A Communiqué will be placed on the Ministry's website in due course to inform applicants that the selection exercise has been completed.
