Scholarships for Research Component of Masters Programme in the field of Hazardous Waste Management

The Africa Institute for the environmentally sound management of hazardous and other wastes - Centre based in Pretoria, South Africa, has secured funding from the Finnish Government on behalf of the Basel Convention member countries for two (2) Research scholarships in the field of hazardous waste management.

2. Conditions

The Scholarship of a maximum of 12 months covers **only** the research component at Master's Level and will not cover tuition fee for the Masters course. The total grant amount will not exceed 40,000 ZAR for the study period and the successful candidate will be required to conduct the research in Mauritius, even if he/she is studying outside the country.

3. Eligibility

Applicants must already be enrolled on a full time basis for a Master's Programme in a recognized institution and be holders of a good first degree in a related discipline.
