

PRESS COMMUNIQUÉ

Lower VI 2011 admission/transfer exercise Information for parents and students

1. The above exercise was carried out in an attempt to fill the **limited** number of vacancies which existed in Lower VI in State Secondary Schools.
2. The applications have been processed by the **Mauritius Examinations Syndicate** and seats in schools have been allocated **subject combination wise**.
3. The order of preference of schools and of subject combinations indicated on the Application Form has been taken into consideration while processing each request.
4. Seats have been allocated on the basis of the **SC grade aggregate** of the students applying for that subject combination in that school.
5. The number of students admitted in each subject combination has been determined by **the number of vacancies available**.
6. Whenever it has not been possible to admit all students who had the same grade aggregate, the **sub aggregate** (i.e. the sum of the grades in the subjects to be taken at Principal Level) has been used to distinguish between the candidates.
7. **Students who have obtained admission/transfer** should register in their new school as indicated in their admission letter. In no case will they be allowed to change the subject combination on the basis of which they have been given admission.
8. **Students who have not obtained admission/transfer** should contact their Rector for advice and guidance. As for those who attended a Form I-V Private Secondary School and who have not obtained admission in a State Secondary School, they are advised to call at the Private Secondary School, Sir Herchenroder Street, Beau Bassin, to apply for a seat in another Private Secondary School.
