SC 2011 Results and Promotion to Lower Six

Following the proclamation of the School Certificate 2011 examination results, the Ministry of Education and Human resources wishes to inform students and their parents of the following:

Since 2011, the Ministry has adopted a flexible approach to allow a greater number of students to gain access to Lower VI. Students having passed SC with 3 credits have now the possibility of being promoted to Lower VI as per specified criteria

Consequently, the Ministry has made the necessary arrangements to ensure that all students who meet the eligibility criteria secure a seat in Lower VI. Schools are being encouraged to accommodate all their eligible students in Lower VI.

Unlike previous years, National Colleges will this year accommodate only their eligible students in Lower VI. There is, accordingly, little likelihood of vacancies arising in these National Colleges.

A further communiqué will be issued shortly regarding vacancies, if any, in State Secondary Schools.

As regards students who attended a Form I-V Private Secondary School and who are eligible for promotion to Lower VI, they are advised to call at the Private Secondary Schools Authority, Sir Herchenroder Street, Beau Bassin, for guidance regarding admission to another Private Secondary School.
