

CORRIGENDUM TO ADVERTISEMENT

Admission of Mauritian students to Universities of The Islamic Republic of Pakistan under the Pakistan Technical Assistance Programme 2011-2012 Session

The attention of potential candidates for scholarships for the above scheme is drawn to Section 2.1 of this Ministry's Communiqué of 2 August 2011. Under "**Eligibility Requirements**" which relates to required grades in connection with:

- (i) Medicine/Dentistry
- (ii) D. Pharmacy; and
- (iii) B Sc Engineering

The requirements should now read:

For Medicine/Dentistry/D.Pharmacy

The minimum aggregate/average marks acquired for subjects taken at Principal Level at HSC/GCE 'A' in Physics, Chemistry and Biology should amount to 60%; and

For B Sc Engineering

The minimum aggregate/average marks acquired for subjects taken at Principal Level at HSC/GCE 'A' in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at one and the same sitting should amount to 60%.

Instead of

grade 'C' in the respective subjects mentioned in the Communiqué dated 02 August 2011.
