

ENLISTMENT OF SUPPLY TEACHERS TO TEACH IN STATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS / COLLEGES

Applications are invited from **suitable candidates outside the service, below the age of 65** who wish to be considered for enlistment as Supply Teacher for the teaching of the subjects listed below in State Secondary Schools/Colleges including prevocational classes. Supply Teachers will be enlisted on a purely temporary basis, as and when required during the academic year 2010 starting in January and ending in October 2010.

2. QUALIFICATIONS AND REMUNERATION

2.1 Candidates should possess a Degree **or** a Diploma in the subject to be taught from a recognized institution **or** a comparable qualification.

For subjects listed from No. 20 to 26 above, candidates possessing at least the Cambridge Higher School Certificate **or** passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the GCE 'A' Level or a qualification of a comparable standard including the subject to be taught may apply and would be considered for enlistment in the absence of candidates possessing a degree or a diploma provided that for **Physical Education** the candidates submit documentary evidence from a recognized organization regarding experience, either:

- (i) as an athlete **or**
- (ii) as an official in a sport or competition **or**
- (iii) as animateur or coach

For subjects No. 27 to 29, candidates possessing at least the Cambridge School Certificate may also apply provided they possess the following additional qualifications:

- (i) For Music (Western), Grade VII, VIII of the Royal Schools of Music **or** an advanced Certificate in Music (Western) **or** a qualification of comparable standard.
- (ii) For Music (Oriental), a Certificate in Music (Oriental) **or** a qualification of comparable standard.
- (iii) For Classical Dance, a Certificate in Classical Dance **or** a qualification of comparable standard.

Their applications will also be considered in the absence of Degree/Diploma/HSC or 2 'A' Level holders.

2.2 Candidates claiming to possess comparable/alternative qualifications to those mentioned at 2.1 above should also produce the equivalence thereof.

2.3 Candidates will be paid fees on a monthly rate, on a pro-rata basis on days on which they actually work, viz:-

- A Rs 19,000 to those who possess a Degree or Joint Degree;
- B Rs 14,200 to those who possess a Diploma;
- C Rs11,200 to those who possess Higher School Certificate or equivalent qualifications or School Certificate + additional qualifications required.

2.4 Bus fares will be refunded on the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates to those **who are under the age of 60.**

The forms should be submitted along with copies of the Birth, Marriage, Academic and Professional Certificates, PSSA Registration Certificate (if available) and evidence of teaching experience.

4. **IMPORTANT**

- (i) Candidates who have already submitted their applications or who are/were already enlisted in the past should submit a **fresh** application on the prescribed form.
- (ii) Candidates should clearly indicate on their Application Forms the subject for which they are applying. Failure to do so may entail their elimination from the competition.
- (iii) **Candidates willing to be considered for more than one subject should fill in separate Application Forms.**
- (iv) **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the applicant.**

Qualified candidates are requested to submit their applications so as to reach the Supervising Officer, (Attn.
