



The Overseas News Service Bulletin

The Overseas News Service (ONS) is a section of the Government Information Service (GIS) of the Prime Minister's Office. It publishes a Bulletin from news relayed from two renowned news agencies, namely Reuters and Agence France Presse. E-subscribers receive three bulletins over 24 hours from the ONS and other subscribers one hard copy daily.

One of the priority objectives of the ONS is to increase awareness of subscribers on international events. The ONS team digests the most important political, economic and sports news and tries to give in its Bulletin a full picture of what is happening around the world. A medical section is included once a week. News is considered in the next few hours it happens, allowing the readers to be up to date with world events. Timeliness and reliability are the key attributes of the Bulletin.

The ONS Bulletin can serve as a very handy and useful tool of reference, since the bulletin, contrary to broadcast media, gives extensive and detailed coverage, in writing, on a really wide range of news stories, issues and problems, and provides subscribers with valuable, helpful and updated notes and background information.

The monthly subscription fee of the ONS Bulletin is Rs 100 for soft copy and Rs 100 (excluding postage) for hard copy.
