

Vacancy for Tradesman (Painter)

Moka/Flacq District Council

Applications are invited from among Tradesman's Assistants of the Local Government Service who wish to be considered for appointment as Tradesman (Painter) in the Moka/Flacq District Council.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in the scale of Rs 8,800 x 200 – 10,200 x 250 – 11,700 x 300 – 13,800 x 400 – 15,000 a month. Appointment in a temporary capacity carries salary at the flat rate of Rs. 8,800 a month.

1. Qualifications :

By selection from among Tradesman's Assistants in the Local Government Service possessing the Trade Test in the appropriate trade or hold a certificate in the appropriate trade from a recognized institution, acceptable to the Local Government Service Commission.

Note: Candidates should enclose copies of their technical/professional qualifications and, where applicable relevant documentary evidence of all experience claimed.

2. Duties :

1. To carry out the necessary measurements and calculations of the trade;
2. To use and keep in good condition the tools in general use in the trade;
3. To remove all paint with soda solution, wash and burn off paint;
4. To prepare surfaces for painting;
5. To make a putty;
6. To sand paper, paint (brush), stop up, flat down with pumice and varnish (brush) and apply putty, paints and varnishes;
7. To do ordinary distempering including preparation of walls if required;
8. To do simple glazing;
9. Must be able to prepare, mix and match paints and to use linseed oil, boiled and raw;
10. To ensure good safety conditions while on duty; and

11. To perform other duties directly related to the main duties above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to them according to their postings

4. Mode of Application

Qualified candidates should submit their applications :
