

International Development Grants Schemes for Performing Artists financed by the Human Resource, Knowledge and Art Development Fund

Government is establishing an International Development Grants Scheme for our most promising artists with a view to opening opportunities for them to improve their skills, market their works and enhance their earning capacity.

The scheme will enable artists to gain international exposure that includes training, collaboration with artists of international repute and to market their works. Artists can respond, every quarter, to call for proposals for the following grants:

- An International Travel Grant of up to Rs 50,000;
- An International Collaboration Grant of up to Rs 150,000; and
- A Marketing Development Grant of up to Rs 100,000.
