Commemoration of the Naval Battle of Grand Port

Invitation for Expressions of Interest for the Registration of Service Providers with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Human Resources (Culture Division)

Mauritius will commemorate the Bicentenary of the Naval Battle of Grand Port in 2010. As this event represents a landmark in the history of Mauritius, a series of activities is being organized from May to August, 2010, and will include , *inter-alia*, a historical village depicting life during the period 1810, sound and light shows, film projections, art exhibitions, publications and international workshops and cultural performances.

In this context, the Ministry is inviting expressions of interest for the enlistment of potential service providers for:-

- (a) podium, marquee, chairs, tables, trestles; Construction of catwalk structure, historical village; foodcourts etc;
- (b) Giant Screens with accessories;
- (c) Stage and light decorations;
- (d) Special Sound/Light/Laser effects;
- (e) Floral decoration;
- (f) manufacture of ship models/ handicrafts/souvenirs for sale;
- (g) operation of foodcourts;
- (h) printing of books, booklets, pamphlets, posters, flyers, banners etc ;
- (i) printing of photograph /documentation on flex;
- (j) Publicity panels including conception, production and fixing of posters on panels;
- (k) Insurance coverage for personnel and workers on site;
- (l) cleaning of site and carting away of debris;
- (m) security services;
- (n) fireworks;
- (o) transport – buses,vans/cars;
- (p) costumes 1810;
- (q) mannequin;
- (r) catering; and
- (s) directional panels.
