

Expressions of Interest
for Registration of Sound and Light Technician at the
Ministry of Arts and Culture

Introduction

The Ministry of Arts and Culture is inviting Expressions of Interest from qualified technicians in the fields of Sound and Light to be registered as resource persons to operate and maintain light and sound equipment at the Serge Constantin Theatre at Vacoas and during outdoor functions organized by the Ministry.

The objective of this exercise is to identify and constitute a pool of technical resource persons to meet the requirements of the Ministry in terms of technical support in the fields of sound and light during various activities that are usually organized. A “Request For Proposals” will be sought from a short list of qualified applicants interested to work for the Ministry. The pool of technicians will report to the Officer In Charge, Serge Constantin Theatre at Vacoas and provide services during events organized by the Ministry. The services will be on an as and when required basis during any day and at any time, including weekends and public Holidays.

Submission

Interested technicians in sound and light should submit their respective Expressions of Interest with all relevant details including:

- a) Full name and age;
- b) Residential address;
- c) Copies of relevant qualifications; and
- d) Evidence of past experience in the field of the required services.

Expressions of Interest, in sealed envelopes, clearly marked “Expressions of Interest for Sound and Light Technicians”, addressed to the Permanent Secretary must be deposited in the **Tender Box, Ministry of Arts and Culture, 7th Floor, Renganaden Seeneevassen Building, Cnr Maillard and Pope Hennessy Streets, Port Louis by Wednesday 6 october 2010 up to 1300 at latest.**

Applicants are strongly advised to take note of the following:-

- a) Amount to be claimed for the services proposed need **not be submitted** and
- b) **Only copies of relevant educational certificates and proof of past experience should be submitted at this stage.**
