SUBJECT: Australia Awards – Australian Leadership Award Fellowships (ALAF)

The Australian Government is opening the Australian Leadership Award Fellowship (ALAF) in 2012 to Mauritius on '*Ocean Governance and Maritime Security*'. This program will include Southern and Eastern African countries along the Indian Ocean facing similar issues and can work collectively across the region to address challenges and foster relations.

2. The program will provide current and emerging leaders and mid-term professionals with awards for short-term research, study and professional leadership development placements with Australian organizations.
3. The course would be aimed at both Policy/Legal officers and operators (i.e. Enforcement Officers) from **fisheries, defence, navy, coast guards, police, customs, maritime safety/transportation, environment, legal and foreign affairs.**
