GREEN PAPER: TOWARDS A MAURICE ILE DURABLE POLICY

As part of the Maurice Ile Durable (MID) process to develop a National Common Shared Vision and a Policy for MID, a series of consultative meetings were held with all segments of the population in the beginning of 2010 to come up with a Green Paper, embodying the needs and aspirations of Mauritians to achieve sustainable development.

The Green Paper summarises the policy formulation process conducted so far and includes a synthesis of the views and **visions** of Government and the Civil Society. It will henceforth serve as a working document for further consultations in order to move towards a consolidated MID Policy.

The Green Paper is now open for public consultations and is accessible on the website of the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development (<http://environment.gov.mu>); at the Resource Centre of the Ministry of Environment & SD (Ground Floor, Ken Lee Tower, Barracks Street, Port Louis) and at all the Municipalities and District Councils.

Members of the public are invited to submit their views and comments by 8th May 2011 at latest, especially on the proposed two visions so as to enable Government to come up with a Common Shared MID Vision, either via email to menv@mail.gov.mu or in writing to the Director of Environment, Department of Environment, Ministry of Environment & SD, 2nd Floor, Ken Lee Tower, Barracks Street, Port-Louis.
