Call for Proposals for Food Security and Renewable Energy Projects in Mozambique

The Government of Mozambique has offered to lease to the Government of Mauritius some 23,500 hectares of land (18,500 hectares in the Province of Maputo and 5,000 in the Province of Manica), subject to the Government of Mauritius coming up with viable and sustainable projects related to the land. For this purpose, the Regional Development Co. Ltd (RDC) has been incorporated as a private company with the Government of Mauritius as shareholder. Its objects include the promotion of regional food security and other regional development projects.

The RDC hereby invites prospective investors to submit technical and financial proposals for any agricultural activity, including processing and support services, and for renewable energy. This Call for Proposal is for projects that can be implemented on a maximum extent of 5,000 hectares only.

Eligibility

This Call for Proposals is open to all investors, regardless of nationality or country of registration as well as to small planters in Mozambique and Mauritius.
