

**Central Electricity Board (Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation-
Collection of Licence Fees) Regulations 1989**

THE CENTRAL ELECTRICITY BOARD ACT

**Regulations made by the Central Electricity Board under section 25 of
the Central Electricity Board Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Central Electricity Board (Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation-Collection of Licence Fees) Regulations 1989.
2. In these regulations-

"Board" means the Central Electricity Board;

"consumer" means a person who is liable to pay an electricity bill and the licence fee;

"licence fee" means the fee specified in the First Schedule to the Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation (Collection of Licence Fees) Act 1984.
3. Every consumer shall pay to the Board his electricity bill, together with the licence fee, within 20 days of the communication of the bill to him.
4. Where a consumer fails to comply with regulation 3 the Board shall be entitled to have his electricity supply cut on forthwith.
5. For the purposes of regulation 3, it shall be sufficient communication of a bill to a consumer where the bill has been left-
 - (a) with him personally; or
 - (b) in his absence, at his premises.
