

The Central Electricity Board (Amendment) Ordinance 1957

Ordinance No. 33 of 1957

An Ordinance

Enacted by the Governor of Mauritius with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

To amend the Central Electricity Board Ordinance, 1951.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of Mauritius, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows-

1. Short title

This Ordinance may be cited as the **Central Electricity Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957**, and shall be read as one with the Central Electricity Board Ordinance, 1951, as subsequently amended, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance.

2. Section 5 of Ord. No.79 of 1951 amended

Section 5 of the principal Ordinance shall have effect as if—

(a) or subsection (1), there were substituted the following subsection-

(1) The Board shall consist of-

- (a) a Chairman;
- (b) the General Manager of the Central Electricity Board;
- (c) a Deputy Financial Secretary to be designated from time to time by the Governor;

- (d) two members of the Electricity Advisory Committee set up under section 16 of this Ordinance nominated by the members thereof from among themselves:

Provided that the appointment of such members shall be subject to the provisions of subsection (4) of this section and that one of them shall be selected to represent the interests of urban consumers of electricity, and the other the interests of rural consumers;

- (ii) The Chairman and the members, other than the Deputy Financial Secretary, shall be appointed by the Governor and shall hold office on such terms as the Governor may decide.

(b)subsection (2) were deleted.
