

MAURITIUS PUBLIC SERVICE

Vacancies for Post of Sanitary Engineer **Ministry of Health and Quality of Life**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Sanitary Engineer in the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the service, should not have reached their **40th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should:

- (a) be Civil Engineers, registered as Registered Professional Engineer with the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius under section 13 of the Registered Professional Engineers Council Act No. 49 of 1965, and as subsequently amended; and
- (b) be computer literate.

NOTE

1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
2. Candidates should submit a copy of their registration certificate as Registered Professional Engineer together with their application form.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To be responsible to the Chief Sanitary Engineer through the Principal Sanitary Engineer for the following:-
 - (a) to design, execute, supervise and manage sanitary works in general, water and wastewater works in particular, including public health institutions;
 - (b) to assist the Regional Public Health Superintendents and other public health personnel on all sanitary and health engineering matters including noise and odour pollution and drinking water supplies;
 - (c) to investigate and monitor environmental issues falling under the purview of the Ministry and submit reports with recommendations thereon;
 - (d) to investigate and carry out surveys pertaining to drinking water pollution;

- (e) to provide technical advice to officers of the technical cadre of the Environmental Health Engineering Unit in the field of sanitary engineering;
 - (f) to examine applications and drawings for morcellement permit, Environmental Impact Assessment and Preliminary Environment Report and to report thereon;
 - (g) to represent the Ministry on committees relating to issues on sanitary engineering;
 - (h) to assist in the training of public health personnel;
 - (i) to assist the Principal Sanitary Engineer in the performance of his duties; and
 - (j) to prepare and submit monthly returns of activities to the Principal Sanitary Engineer.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Sanitary Engineers in the roles ascribed to them.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 22,000 x 600 – 23,200 x 800 – 28,000 x 1,000 – 30,000 x 1,250 – 40,000 a month plus salary compensation at approved rates.

V. FRINGE BENEFITS

Sanitary Engineers are entitled to the following benefits:

- (a) 100% customs duty remission for the purchase of a new car with petrol engine capacity of up to 1,500 cc renewable once every seven years;
- (b) loan facilities for the first purchase of a car equivalent to 18 months' salary at 7.5% interest rate per annum, refundable in 84 monthly instalments;
- (c) a monthly travelling allowance of Rs 8,480 both for attending duty and for official travelling; and
- (d) refund of total amount of annual subscription fee to the Council of Registered Professional Engineers up to a maximum of Rs 5,200 annually.

VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Civil Service and Administrative Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commission/Embassies overseas.
2. Candidates already in the service should submit their application **in duplicate**, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising/ Responsible Officers.
