

MAURITIUS PUBLIC SERVICE

Vacancies for Post of Technical and Mechanical Officer **Ministry of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit,** **Land Transport and Shipping (Public Infrastructure Division)**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Technical and Mechanical Officer in the Ministry of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit, Land Transport and Shipping (Public Infrastructure Division).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the service, should not have reached their **40th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

1. Candidates should possess:

- A.** a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French, Mathematics and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings or

passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French, Mathematics and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations;

- B.** a Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate or passes in Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”; and

- C.** a diploma in Automobile Engineering or a 'Brevet de Technicien Supérieur en Génie Automobile' from a recognised institution.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to **A**, **B** and **C** above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

- 2.** Candidates should also have:-
- (i) at least two years' experience in repair and maintenance of vehicles; and
 - (ii) a valid driving licence for cars, vans and lorries.

NOTE

- 1. Qualification at **1.A** above should have been obtained prior to qualification at **1.B** above.
- 2. Candidates should produce written evidence of experience claimed.
- 3. The Commission reserves the right to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To supervise and monitor maintenance and repair works on vehicles at the workshop.
- 2. To ensure the availability of spare parts/materials at the different sections of the Workshop.
- 3. To assist and guide tradesmen on technical matters.
- 4. To ensure that health and safety measures are put in place and complied with.
- 5. To ensure proper housekeeping at the workshop.
- 6. To survey and report on vehicles involved in accidents and attend courts in that connection, as and when required.
- 7. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 14,200 x 400 – 15,000 x 500 – 16,000 x 600 – 23,200 x 800 – 28,000 x 1,000 – 29,000 a month plus salary compensation at approved rates.

V. MODE OF APPLICATION

1. 2. Candidates already in the service should submit their application **in duplicate**, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising/Responsible Officers.
