NOTES AND INSTRUCTIONS

General

1. This application form should solely be used for exportation of radioactive sources.
2. Each section of this application form must be duly completed. Use the abbreviation "N/A" for *Not Applicable* wherever appropriate.
3. The duly filled in application form should be sent to: ***The Chief Radiation Protection Officer, Radiation Protection Authority, 37, Saint Georges Street, Port Louis.***
4. If the application is in order, a reply will be made to the Applicant within 15 days from the date the application form is received by the Authority. The Applicant should, therefore, ensure that the application form is submitted to the Authority in a timely manner.
5. The Authority will not be responsible for any delay in the processing of the application resulting from incomplete and/or illegible form.

Section 1

6. The Applicant is responsible for the proper packing of the radioactive source(s) and same should be in conformity with the international requirements for the transportation of radioactive sources.

Section 2

7. The Contact Person is a person in the Applicant's Organisation/Department who may be contacted for additional information or clarification by the Authority. Note that the Contact Person may also be the Applicant.

Section 5

8. The Contact Person is a person in the Consignee's Organisation/Department who may be contacted by the Authority for any additional information/clarification.

Section 6

9. This section must be duly completed in the case where the exportation of the radioactive source(s) is/are being undertaken by a Local Exporting Agent.
10. The Contact Person is a person in the Local Exporting Agent's Organisation/Department who may be contacted by the Authority for any additional information or clarification.

Section 7

11. The Country of Destination is the country to which the radioactive source(s) is/are being exported.
12. The Despatch Date is the expected date when the consignment containing the radioactive source(s) will be despatched to the Consignee.

Sections 3, 4 and 8

13. These sections are self-explanatory.
