NOTES AND INSTRUCTIONS

General

1. This application form should solely be used for the importation of radiation sources.
2. Each section of this application form must be duly completed. Use the abbreviation "N/A" for *Not Applicable* wherever appropriate.
3. The duly filled-in application form should be submitted to: ***The Chief Radiation Protection Officer, Radiation Protection Authority, 37, Saint Georges Street, Port Louis.***
4. If the application is in order, a reply will be made to the Applicant within 15 days from the date the application form is received by the Authority. The Applicant should, therefore, ensure that the application form is submitted to the Authority in a timely manner.
5. The Authority will not be responsible for any delay in the processing of the application resulting from incomplete and/or illegible form.

For Section 1

6. The Applicant should be the Head of the Organisation/Department which intends to use the radiation source(s) to be imported.
7. The Applicant will be responsible for the safety and security of the radiation source(s) to be imported, and shall therefore ensure that his Organisation/Department has the necessary radiation protection infrastructure in place for their safe use, handling and storage.

For Section 2

8. The Contact Person is a person in the Applicant's Organisation/Department who may be contacted by the Authority for any additional information or clarification. Note that the Contact Person may also be the Applicant.

For Section 5

11. The Contact Person is a person in the Overseas Supplier's Organisation/Department who may be contacted by the Authority for any additional information or clarification.
12. If the radiation source(s) is/are being purchased, a Pro-Forma Invoice from the Overseas Supplier should be submitted to the Radiation Protection Authority together with the duly filled-in application form.

For Section 6

13. This section must be duly completed in the case where the importation of the radiation source(s) is/are being undertaken by a Local Importing Agent.
14. The Contact Person is a person in the Local Importing Agent's Organisation/Department who may be contacted by the Authority for any additional information or clarification.

For Section 7

15. The Country of Origin is the country from which the radiation source(s) is/are being imported.
16. The Despatch Date is the expected date when the consignment containing the radiation source(s) will be despatched by the Overseas Supplier.

For Sections 3, 4 and 8

17. These sections are self-explanatory.
