- give young people the opportunity to:
  - present/display their involvement in social, economic, cultural, artistic and other youth-related fields;
  - demonstrate their project management skills;
- reward outstanding Project implementations and;
- highlight Projects which demonstrate a sense of initiative and search for excellence by young people.

## INVITATION FOR PARTICIPATION

1. Participation is invited from all young people, boys and girls, between 14 and 29 years of age (in 2011).
2. Participation forms duly filled in, should be forwarded to the Rose Belle Youth Centre or to the Youth Centre nearest to participants' locality by Saturday 07 May 2011 at latest.
3. Participants should also fill in the "Descriptive Presentation of Project Forms" and forward same to the Rose Belle Youth Centre or to any Youth Centre convenient to participants by Saturday 11 June 2011 at latest.
4. Group Leaders should ensure that:
  - All their members' names are written as per their birth certificates/ID Cards and;
  - the personal telephone numbers and addresses of group members are submitted;

## VERY IMPORTANT

Young people should choose any one Area of Interest from the list below and work in groups not exceeding 7 members:

1. Agriculture, Youth Employment and Enterprise Initiatives,
2. Arts and Crafts Promotion
3. Family Life and Human Values
4. Preservation/Protection of the Environment
5. Youth Leadership and Community Work

Projects should either:

- (i) be ongoing or
- (ii) have already started by Saturday 30 April 2011

Participants should:

1. provide accurate information on their respective Descriptive Presentation of Project form;
2. be prepared to meet Adjudicators during the months of July to September 2011.

Participants in Family Life and Human Values may either

- (i) present to Adjudicators what they are doing on the field or
- (ii) submit the script of a role-play, which should be performed by 4-6 group members, for Adjudicators, to depict situations and proposals by Saturday 02 July 2011.

Medium – English, French or Creole  
Duration – 7 to 10 minutes.

## PRIZES

The winner of each Area of Interest will receive a cash prize of Rs 30,000 and a souvenir Trophy.

Nominees of each Area of Interest will receive a cash prize of Rs 5,000.

A Certificate of Participation will be given to every participant in the Youth Excellence Award 2011.
