**THE TOURISM AUTHORITY ACT 2006**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 129 of the  
Tourism Authority Act 2006**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Tourism Authority (Speed Limit and Prohibited Activity Zone for Pleasure Craft) (Trou d'Eau Douce) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.
2. In these regulations –  
“principal regulations” means the Tourism Authority (Speed Limit and Prohibited Activity Zone for Pleasure Craft) (Trou d'Eau Douce) Regulations 2008.
3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Schedule to these regulations.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 15 April 2008.

Made by the Minister on 4 April 2008.

**SCHEDULE***(regulation 3)***SECOND SCHEDULE***(regulations 2 and 4)***Speed limit zone****Part A - Description of speed limit zone**

The area of the speed limit zone is the stretch of the sea from the high water mark to the coral reefs, which is delimited by buoys having the following coordinates:

Starting from point B1 located on the coast in the direction of the Telecommunications Tower at Trou D'Eau Douce having grid coordinates 1027680 mE, 995555 mN and Geographical coordinates 20° 14' 17.0"S, 57° 47' 37.6" E the limit runs along an imaginary line in a southerly direction and meets point B2 on the coast of Ilot Mangenie having grid coordinates 1029220 mE, 993390 mN and Geographical coordinates 20° 15' 27.4"S, 57° 48' 30.8" E. From this point the limit runs along another imaginary line in a southerly direction up to point B3 on the coast of Ile aux Cerfs at Pte Grand Vacoas having grid coordinates 1029385mE, 991460 mN and Geographical coordinates 20° 16' 30.1" S, 57° 48' 36.6" E. Thence the limit runs along an imaginary line in a south westerly direction up to point B4 on the coast at Pte aux Feuilles having grid coordinates 1026275 mE, 987180 mN and Geographical coordinates 20° 18' 49.4" S, 57° 46' 49.6" E. Thereafter, the limit follows the high water mark along the coast up of Pte aux Feuilles in a general northerly direction up to point B1.

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- Notes:** (a) Grid coordinates are based on the National Grid System of Mauritius which is referenced on Clarke 1880 datum and the geographical coordinates are referenced to the World Geodetic System 1984 ( WGS 84).
- (b) mE means metre East
- (c) mN means metre North

**Part B - Plan of speed limit zone**
