On the 8th September 2011, the Commission held a meeting where the Commissioners have taken cognizance of the following:

Facts of the Case

On 25th May 2011, the Executive Director of the Competition Commission of Mauritius (CCM) started an Investigation on the proposed commingling of pools by Automatic Systems Limited (ASL) and Globalsports Limited (GSL).

On 16th June 2011, the CCM issued a Statement of Issues whereby it expressed its concerns about the said commingling of pools, in that the proposed commingling of pools Agreement between ASL and GSL might be in breach of section 41 of the Competition Act 2007 (the Act)

On 11th August 2011, ASL and GSL offered Undertakings to the CCM pursuant to Section 63 of the Act, in an attempt to address the competition concerns of the CCM as set out in the Statement of Issues.

Upon receipt of the Undertakings by ASL and GSL, the Executive Director of the CCM produced a Final Report on 5th September 2011 titled: 'Commingling of Pools between Automatic Systems Ltd and Globalsports Ltd'.
