SALE BY PUBLIC TENDER OF USED VEHICLES, CHASSIS, SPARE PARTS AND MACHINERY AS SCRAP METAL

1. Bids on appropriate forms are invited from members of the public including traders, dealers, companies, etc, for the sale on an 'AS IS WHERE IS' basis of above mentioned.
2. The goods may be viewed at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge and at Mauritius Marine Authority Park as from Wednesday 24th March to Tuesday 30th March 2010 from 10.00 hrs to 15.00 hrs on weekdays and from 09.30 hrs to 11.00 hrs on Saturday.
3. The Bid Form may be downloaded from the Mauritius Revenue Authority's website: <http://mra.gov.mu> or collected from the Registry Section, 3rd Floor, Customs Department, IKS Building, Port Louis and also from the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse at Lux Shed, Mer Rouge as from Wednesday 24th March 2010.
4. Tenders duly filled should be addressed in sealed envelopes marked " Tender Quotation 01 of 2010 and deposited in the Tender Box at the Registry Section IKS Building (Customs House) Trou Fanfaron Port Louis or at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge by Tuesday 30th.March 2010 up to 15 00 hrs (local time) at latest.
5. **Offers should be open and remain valid for acceptance for a period of two months with effect from the closing date, and should be accompanied by a bank cheque drawn in favour of Director General, MRA for an amount of Rs 5000 as deposit. Upon acceptance of offer, the bank cheque will be automatically treated as non-refundable and will be realised and enforced immediately.**
6. Offers received after the prescribed date and time shall not be considered.
7. Price shall be quoted per ton.
8. Goods shall be subject for dismantling after determination of the exact weight at the expense of the bidder and delivery shall be effected under supervision of a Customs Officer.
9. Successful bidders shall effect payment and take delivery of ALL ITEMS AWARDED within 2 weeks as from the date of the letter of award, failing which the offer will lapse. Payment can only be effected either in cash or Office Bank Cheque drawn in favour of Director General MRA.
10. The MRA reserves the right:
 - a. To accept or reject any bid, or
 - b. To annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of the tender without thereby incurring any liability or any obligation to inform any bidder of the grounds for accepting or rejecting any bid.
11. Bidders are not allowed to bid for the same items more than once.
12. Tenders with erasures or written with lead pencils shall be rejected.
13. VISITORS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING ALONG THEIR IDENTITY CARDS FOR ACCESS AND REGISTRATION PURPOSES AT THE PORT MAIN GATE.
