Bids on appropriate forms are invited from members of the public including traders, dealers, companies, etc, for the sale on an 'AS IS WHERE IS' basis of above mentioned goods.

1. **The goods may be viewed at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge as from Wednesday 28th November 2007 to Saturday 1st December 2007 from 10.00 hrs to 15.00 hrs on weekdays and from 09.30 hrs to 11.00 hrs on Saturday 1st December 2007.**

4. Tenders duly filled in should be deposited in the Tender Box at the Registry Section IKS Building (Customs House) Trou Fanfaron Port Louis or at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge **by Saturday 1st December 2007 up to 11 00 hrs (local time) at latest.**
5. Offers received after the prescribed date and time shall not be considered.
6. Bidders may bid in any quantity indicating the quoted price per unit/set/lot.
7. Successful bidders shall effect payment and take delivery of ALL ITEMS AWARDED within 2 weeks as from the date of the letter of award, failing which the offer will lapse. Payment can only be effected either in cash or Office Bank Cheque drawn in favour of Director General MRA.
8. The MRA reserves the right:
 - (a) To accept or reject any bid, or
 - (b) To split the bid, or
 - (c) To annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of the tender without thereby incurring any liability or any obligation to inform any bidder of the grounds for accepting or rejecting any bid.
9. Bidders are not allowed to bid for the same items more than once.
10. VISITORS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING ALONG THEIR IDENTITY CARDS FOR ACCESS AND REGISTRATION PURPOSES AT THE PORT MAIN GATE.
