(iii) I am also aware that I shall be liable to pay the full amount of the excise duty and value added tax, representing the concession granted, plus a penalty of 10 percent thereon should
(a) the motor vehicle/motor cycle be sold, pledged or otherwise disposed of within a period of 4 years from the date of its importation;
(b) I fail to submit the evidence referred to in paragraph (ii) above.
