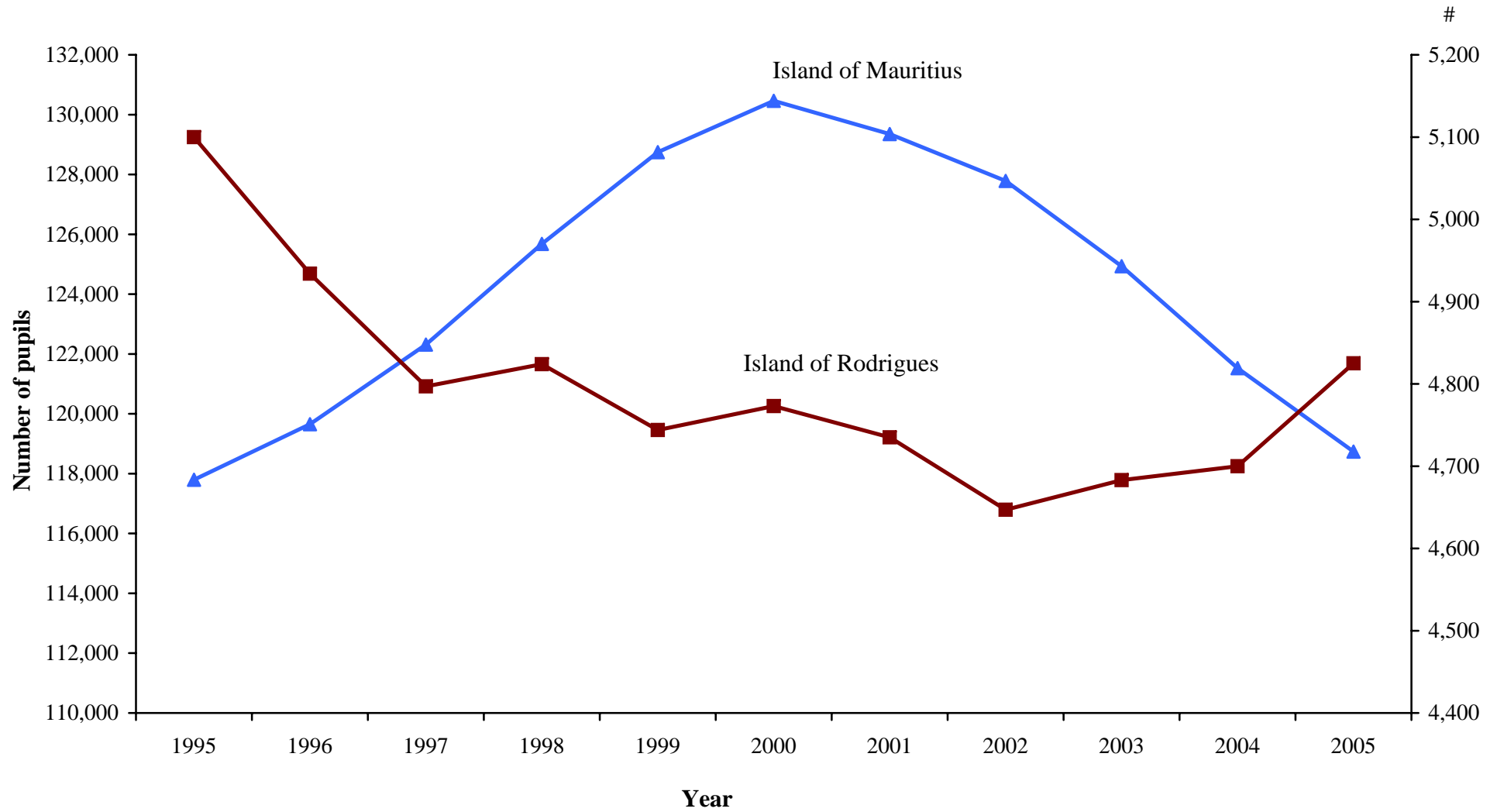

Fig. 4 - Gross Enrolment Ratio at Primary level, 1995 - 2005

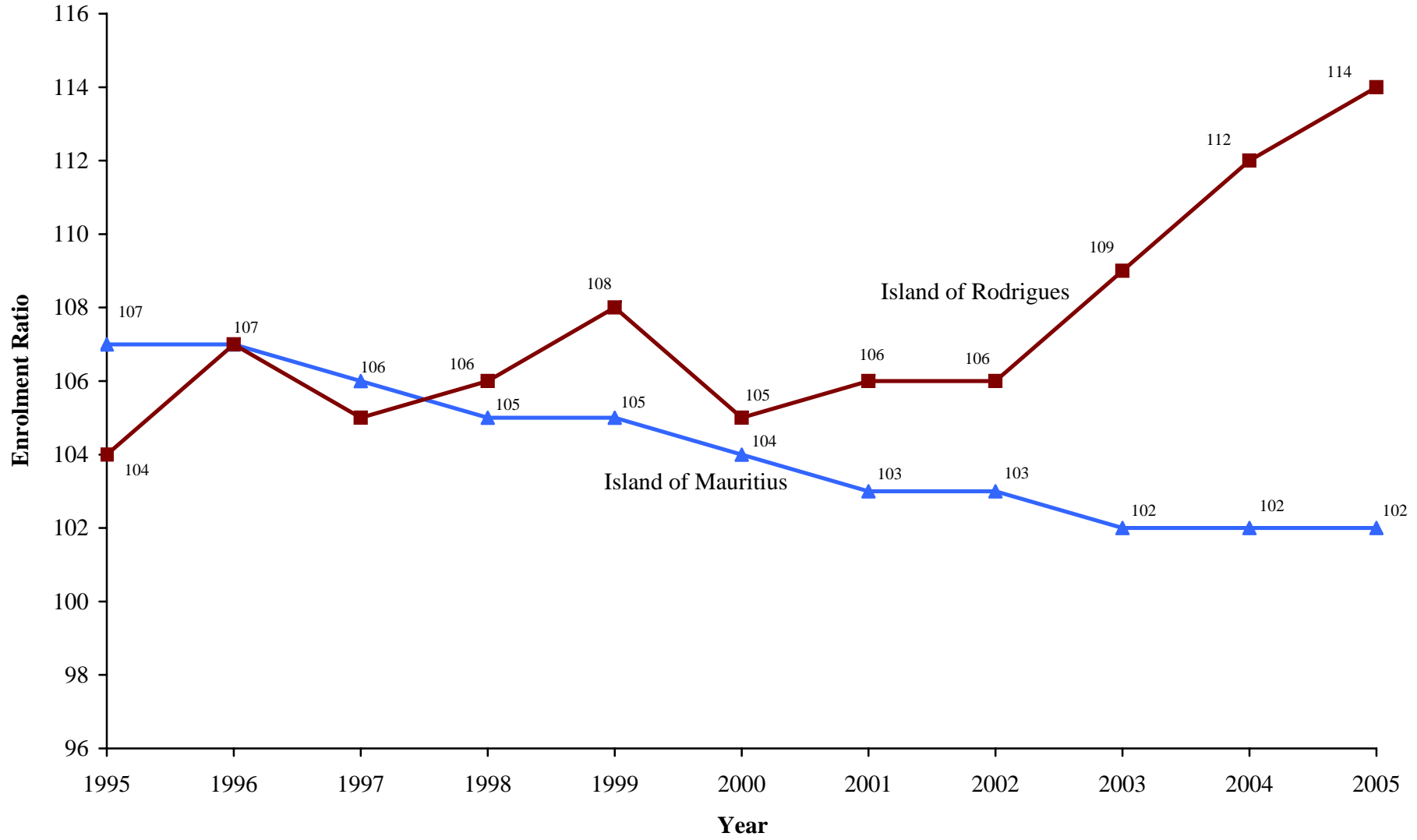

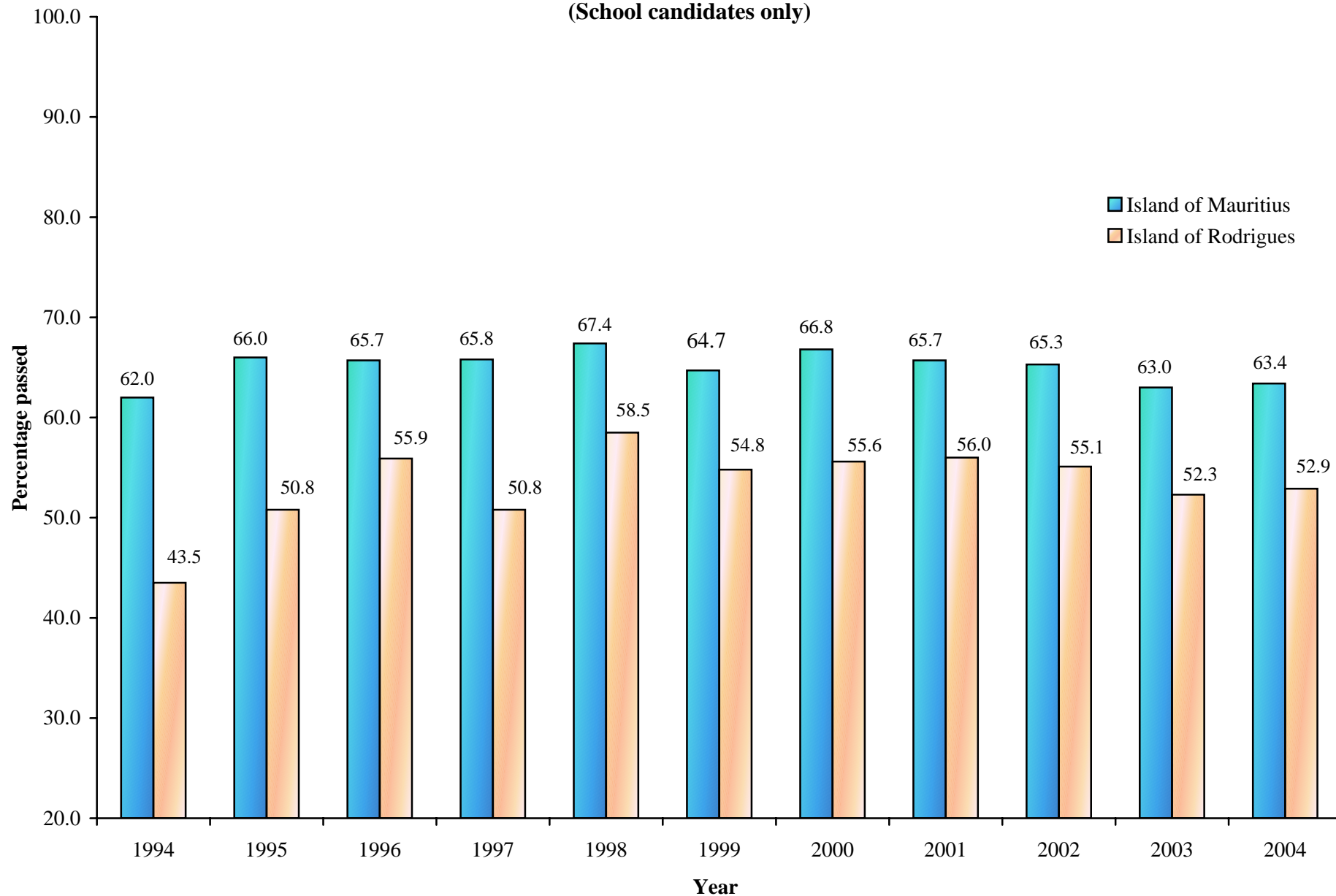
