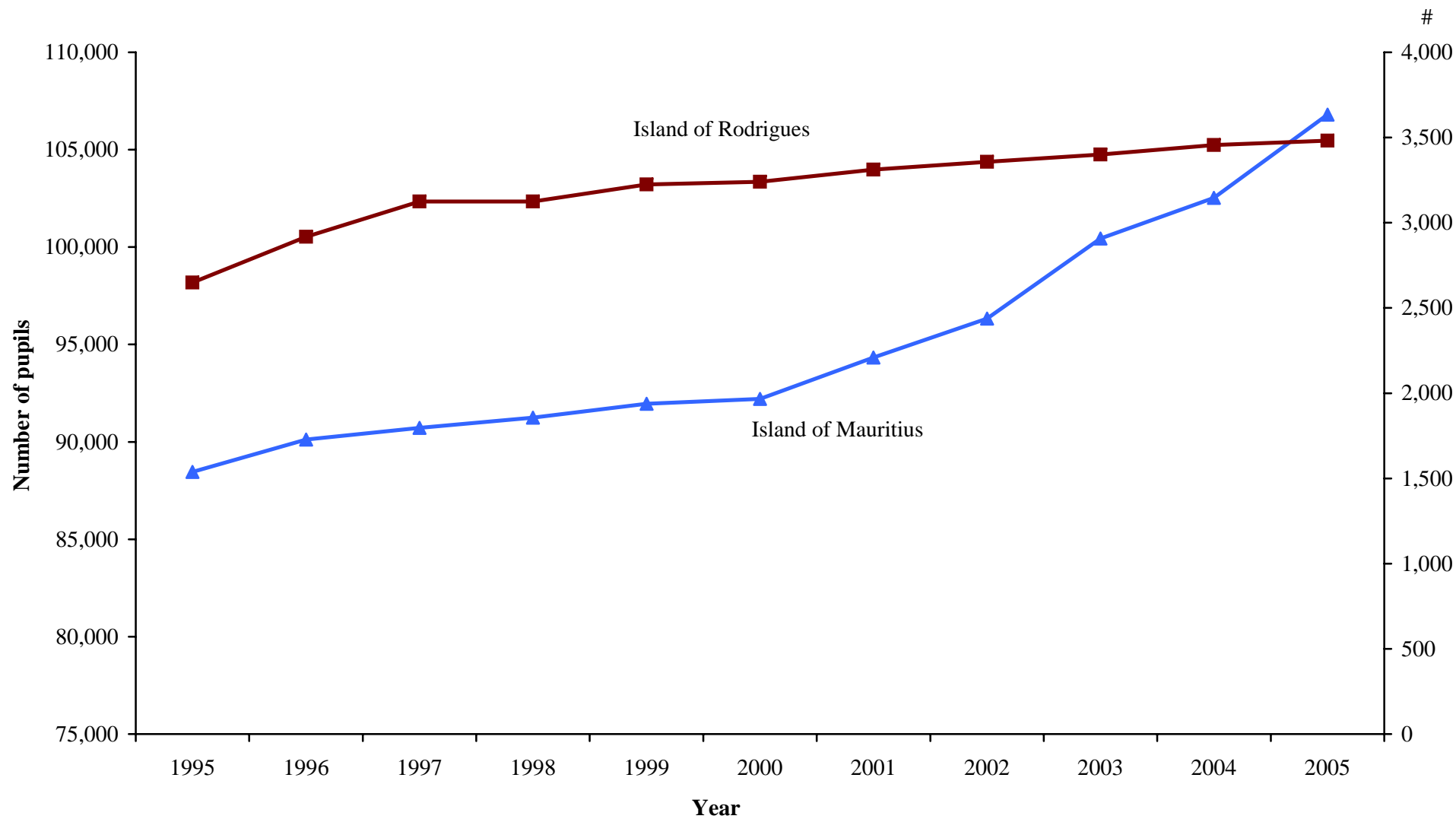

Fig. 7 - Gross Enrolment Ratio at Secondary level (Academic only), 1995 - 2005

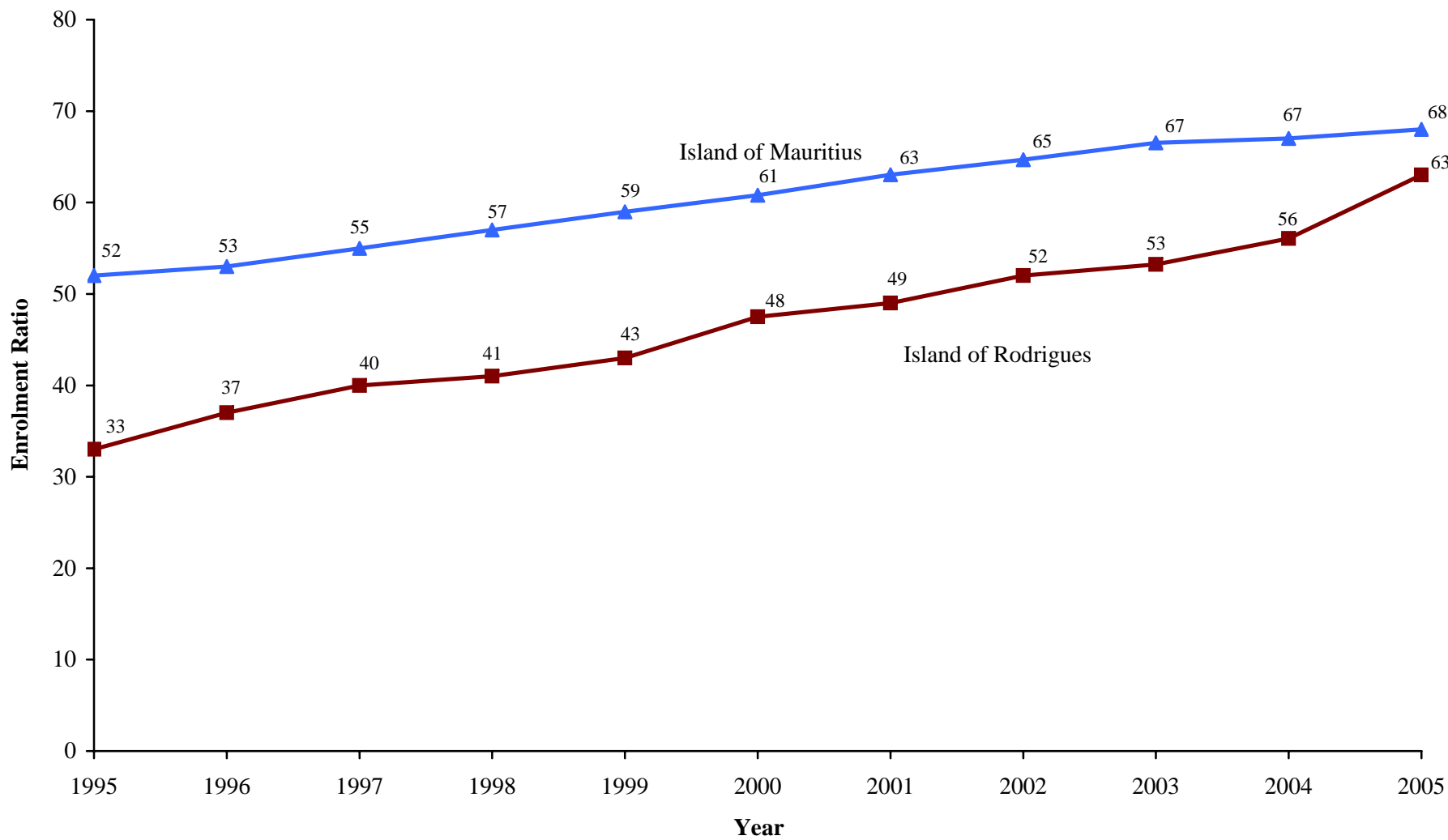

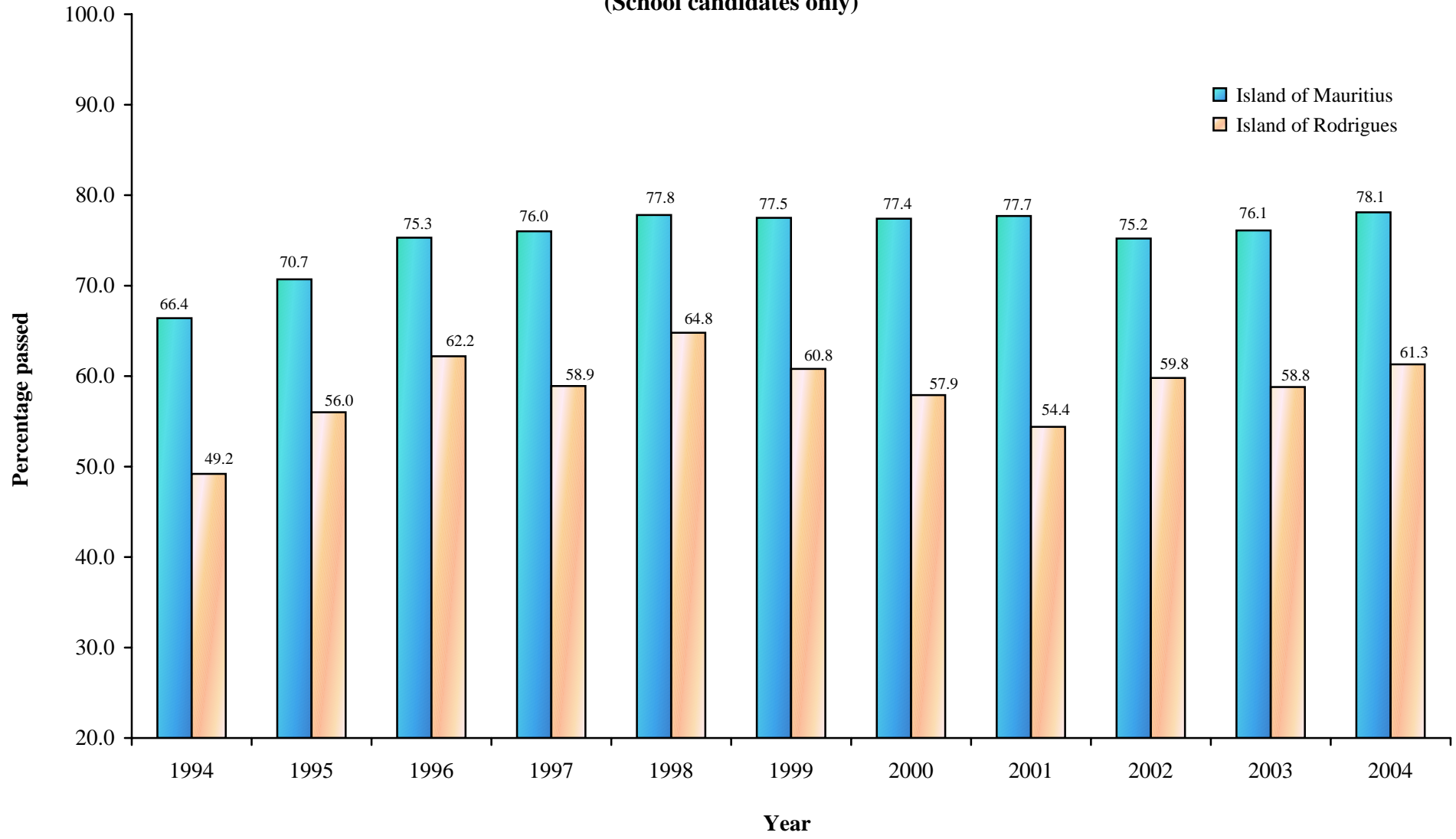

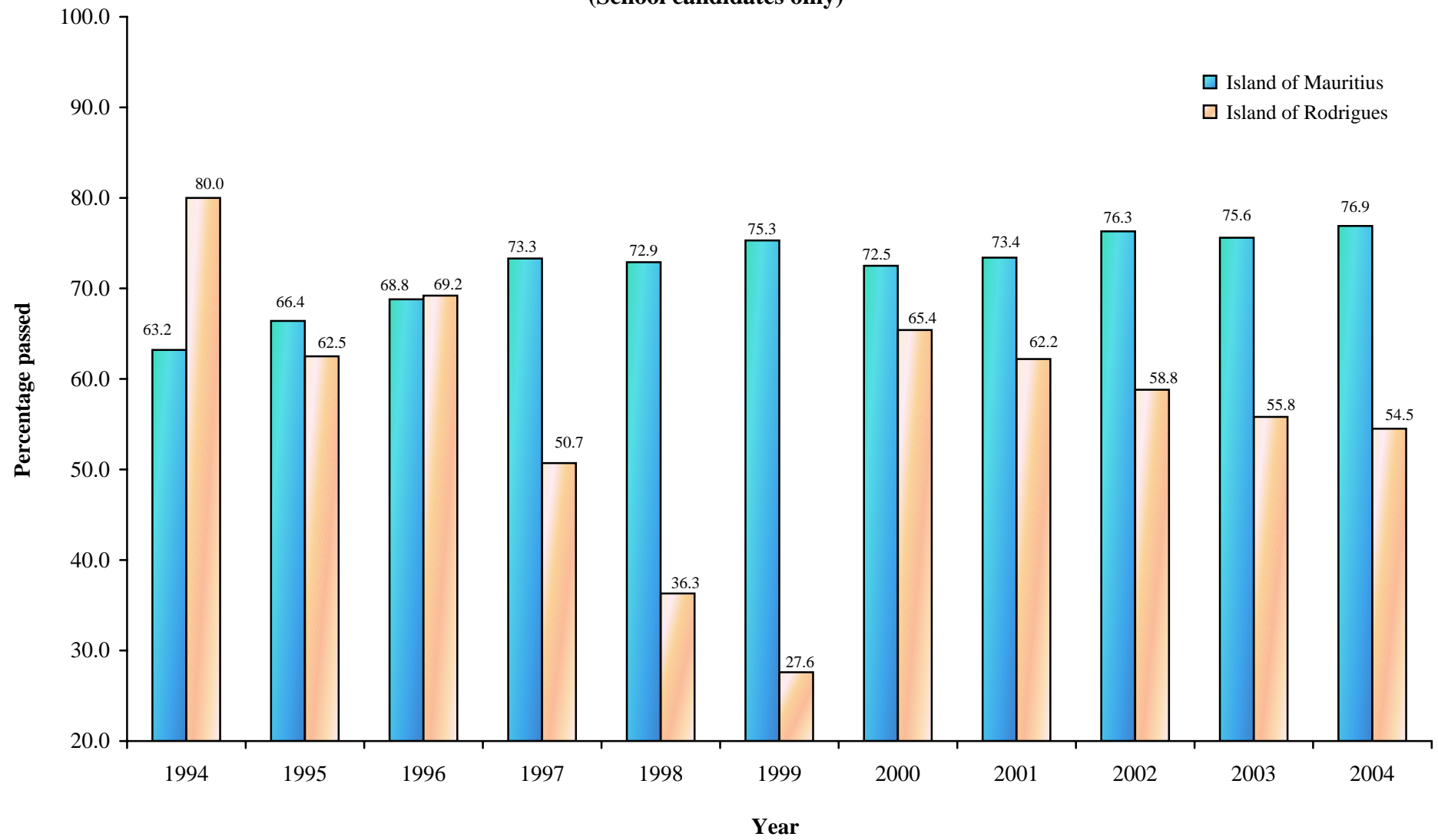
