**Registration of widows of Peacetime Ex-Servicemen**

Following the decision of government to extend financial assistance to widows of Peacetime Ex-Servicemen, all widows whose late husband has served in the army during post-war period (1945-1956) are hereby requested to register themselves to be eligible for same.

Widows should report at the nearest **Citizen Advice Bureau** of their residence or at the **Mauritius Ex-Services Trust Fund** during week-days as from 16 July to 14 September 2007 (office hours only).

Originals as well as photocopies of the following documents should be produced at time of registration.

- (a) **Documents in regards to late Ex-Servicemen**
  - (i) Army Discharge Certificate.
  - (ii) Death Certificate.
  - (iii) Affidavit if there was change in name.
  
- (b) **Documents in regards to widow**
  - (i) National Identity Card
  - (ii) Marriage Certificate / Attestation of religious marriage  
(where applicable)
  - (iii) Bank Account Number
  - (iv) Affidavit if there was change in name.
