• **Polytechniques Institutions**

There are 22 reserved seats in the three polytechnique institutions, namely: 8 seats at Swami Dayanand Institute of Management, 6 seats at Institut Supérieur de Technologies, 8 seats at Lycée Polytechnique Sir Guy Forget

Those who have not been offered a reserved seat, the registration fees, tuition fees and exams fees are borne by the Rodrigues Regional Assembly.

- **Monthly Stipend**

A monthly stipend of Rs 3000.- is awarded to needy students studying in Mauritius based on the following criteria:

- * Student from low income family
- * Student should be studying in a recognized institution
- * Student should be studying at tertiary or post secondary level
- * Student should not in receipt of any scholarship
- * Student should have followed at least three years of primary and either Form IV to Form V or Form IV to Form VI in Rodrigues.

- **Government Quarters**

Accommodations depending availability of vacant rooms are provided upon request from students studying in Mauritius for the duration of studies only. Each tenant has to sign an agreement with the Rodrigues Regional Assembly ensuring that rules and regulations are strictly followed.
