TAKEN NOTE:

- (i) in line with Budget Speech 2011, the Commission for Education will provide school materials, namely a pair of shoes and a school bag to all needy newly admitted pupils to pre-primary, primary and secondary schools whose family income is lower than Rs 8,500, per month. The aim of this measure is to alleviate the financial burden faced by parents coming from poor socio economic background to provide school materials to their children.
